

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON APRIL 13, 2016 IN THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS OF MARTINSVILLE, ILLINOIS.

Roll call was answered by the following council members and elected officials: Chris Davidson, Mike Cribelar, Herman Davidson, Fred Clement, Gordon Crutchfield and David Doran. Also in attendance were Clerk Marlene Wilhoit and Treasurer Melinda Short with Mayor Reeds absent. Employees and citizens in attendance are attached to the back of the minutes.

\*\*Motion by Cribelar 2<sup>nd</sup> by Clement to approve minutes from 03-09-16 council meeting, 03-23-16 committee meeting.

Upon roll call vote all council members present voted for the motion. (6)

\*\*Motion by H Davidson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by C Davidson to approve Treasurer's report as presented.

Upon roll call vote all council members present voted for the motion. (6)

\*\*Motion by Cribelar 2<sup>nd</sup> by C Davidson to approve March 2016 bills payable in April 2016 in the amount of \$100,917.28.

Upon roll call vote all council members present voted for the motion. (6)

\*\*Motion by H Davidson 2<sup>nd</sup> by Crutchfield to approve a journal entry transfer of \$80,816.20 from the payroll clearing fund to the general fund for FY 2014 & 2015 per audit request.

Upon roll call vote all council members present voted for the motion. (6)

\*\*Motion by H Davidson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cribelar to approve Ordinance No. 2014-4-1 titled: "an ordinance to approve the editing and inclusion of certain ordinances as parts of the various component codes of the codified ordinances".

Upon roll call vote all council members present voted for the motion. (6)

Norma Calvert, representing Martinsville on the Move updated council on their current events and requested an approved street closure for the follow streets: Mill Street from Cumberland to Vine and Vine Street from Mill to the Littlejohn Elevator for the following dates in 2016: May 27, June 10, July 9, July 23, July 30, August 6, August 13, August 19, September 25, October 1 and December 10. She also requested "No Parking" signage and barricades.

\*\*Motion by C Davidson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by H Davidson to approve the street closures for the above dates for activity at Linn Park.

Upon roll call vote all council members present voted for the motion. (6)

Norma Calvert and Joyce Bishop expressed concern with Economic Development for Martinsville and if because of a lack of funds suggested maybe forming a committee of volunteers that could get some type of packet together to have ready for interested potential developers. She also expressed her feeling on pursuing the new housing development that the City of Marshall turned done and suggested the City send a formal letter expressing their interest.

The tenants living at 676 E Schofield recently incurred expenses to fix a personal sewer problem and inquired if the City would help pay for this problem. It is not the City's responsibility for individual sewer problems and the issue was not even discussed.

Mike Cribelar handed out a map of the city categorizing areas of the city that need attention to drainage and ditching which was discussed by council. The street & alley committee will meet with the Mayor to get this implemented.

Council discussed signage to be placed at fence on South York and next to the city's burn area. An ordinance will be passed at the next meeting imposing a fine of \$500.00 for anyone caught dumping anything besides leaves, sticks and yard waste. This will also be addressed in the Library Newsletter that is sent to every home.

\*\*Motion by Cribelar, 2<sup>nd</sup> by C Davidson to approve imposing a fee \$500 for dumping in the City.
