

Minutes of the City of Martinsville, Committee meeting held on April 26, 2017 at 7:00 PM in council chambers.

People in attendance were; Council members; Chris Davidson, Mike Cribelar, Herman Davidson, Gordon Crutchfield, David Doran and City Clerk L Marlene Wilhoit. Audience attendants were Phil Reeds, Mike Kraemer and John Skinner.

Agenda items discussed:

American Legion request permission to install welcome signs: Gordon Crutchfield Commander of American Legion Post 515 asked for permission to erect signs at the 4 entrances into Martinsville. They had signs in the past that are gone or badly faded. They are going to have 4 signs made hoping to attract more members to their organization that was established in 1920. The big welcome sign board on North York Street has a Lion's club sign on it that could be removed as there is no longer a Lion's club. The council will consider this for vote at the May 3rd council meeting.

Discussion on liquor licensing change: Discussion on a new added license resulted in mixed feelings about ability to have open liquor in Martinsville. This will be voted on at the first meeting for old business on May 3rd.

Dealing with the election on April 4th and seating new members the council voted to change the meeting date for the council meeting from May 10th to May 3rd and leave the date for the May committee meeting as May 24th.

Mayor Reeds reminded council they need to consider redoing one of the three rural water lines in the near future. The three lines being the completion of the Baird water line, the Cochran water line and the Cribelar water line. They need to replace these 2" mains with 4" mains.

Clerk Wilhoit reminded council they will need to update their OMA and FOIA on-line classes. She will get information to all. She also requested the council members pick up their meeting packets on the Friday before the meeting.

Marlene Wilhoit informed council that she has lost her part time help and with council permission will start looking for a qualified replacement.
