

Redistricting (Census) Committee Meeting was held on September 8, 2022 in the City Council Chambers of Martinsville, Illinois.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30pm by Committee Chairman Melinda Lovell. Also in attendance were committee member Ashley Wilhoit, Clerk Jana Akers, and Mayor Herman Davidson.

Alders Lovell and Wilhoit discussed the numbers that they came up with. The total number of people in the city of Martinsville according to the last Census was 1,118. They calculated the numbers to make sure each ward was within 5% of the others as it is required.

They also made sure that each ward was touching, as that is also required. The two of them came together to determine that Ward 1 should now consist of 362 people from its prior amount of 320 people; Ward 2 should now consist of 375 people from its prior 579 people; and Ward 3 should now consist of 381 people from its prior amount of 219 people.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:20 pm
